The Convenor is due to lead a day on Community Audit in Kirkcudbright and Gatehouse-on-Fleet in March. The team is also looking at other ways in which Bethany can work with smaller charges in a way that they feel they "can do". There is a desire to open up a day of thinking about Food-banks and all the risks, responsibilities, positives and negatives which they bring. St Augustine's Dumbarton would be heavily involved with that, and a date is being sought in the Diocesan calendar.

The Vicars' Relief Fund is still sadly underused by charges, and despite appeals, very few folk are asking for small grants. However there may be some exciting stuff coming from St Mungo's' Alexandria in the near future which needs funding.
